

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
NORTH SONOMA COAST FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF SONOMA COUNTY,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, SETTING DISTRICT APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2020-2021

WHEREAS, Article XIII B of the Constitution of the State of California establishes limits on the appropriations of tax proceeds by government entities; and

WHEREAS, the North Sonoma Coast Fire Protection District ("District") is a duly recognized independent fire protection district in the state of California pursuant to the Fire Protection District Law of 1987, California Health and Safety Code section 13800 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2018, pursuant to California Government Code section 56811, the District voters approved a permanent District appropriations limit in the amount of \$3,000,000.00 for Fiscal Year 2018-2019; and

WHEREAS, the District has received annual adjustment data provided by the Sonoma County Auditor-Controller-Treasurer-Tax Collector, for determination of the District appropriations limit for Fiscal Year 2020-2021; and

WHEREAS, a notice has been published stating that the District would conduct a public hearing for consideration of the District appropriations limit for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, based on annual adjustment data provided by the Sonoma County Auditor-Controller-Treasurer-Tax Collector, the Board of Directors of the North Sonoma Coast Fire Protection District does hereby approve and adopt a District appropriations limit in the amount of \$3,193,031.00 for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.
