# **NSCFPD Board Meeting Action Summary**

Wednesday, October 16, 2024,10:00 a.m. Sea Ranch North Fire Station (39250 Highway One, The Sea Ranch, CA, 95497)

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  - I. **CALL TO ORDER**: The meeting was called to order at 09:59 a.m.
- II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE
- III. **ROLL CALL**: In attendance: Directors Nybakken, Gardener, Campbell, Tittle, Colson, Chief Plakos, District Administrator Daymon Doss, CAL FIRE Captain Pat Briant
- IV. **REMOTE ATTENDANCE**: None

- VI. PUBLIC COMMENT ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS: None
- VII. **CONSENT CALENDAR** A motion was made to approve the consent calendar by Dir. Gardener, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dir. Nybakken, and approved by a vote of 5-0.

#### VIII. REPORTS

- A. Chair: Welcomed Daymon Doss, our new District Administrator. Thanked Chief Plakos for everything she has done to prepare for Daymon's arrival. The process of setting up a repeat of the workshop for building fire stations (held on Sept 19) is in progress. No progress yet on the board retreat.
- B. Chief: as written, also: 4490 is back in service; there is some seasonable shuffling of equipment between the north and south fire stations; there is a red flag warning through the weekend; it is very likely that the hazardous pickup day will occur as planned; reminded us that the North Fire Station is the local polling place; explained REDCOM.
- C. CAL FIRE: There is one major fire in the state near Shasta; discussed the Muniz fire near Jenner, and discussed the causes of fires in general; gave a short-term weather report; 2 additional engineers are starting soon at CAL FIRE in preparation for the official increase of the team on January 1.
- D. District Administrator: His first day was Monday; onboarding is going very well; discussed what he is looking for in local housing; wants to meet with each board member in the coming weeks.
- E. VFA Liaison: Eric Agnew from the VFA gave a presentation of the current North Fire Station expansion plans and financial status.
- F. Treasurer: as written; one clarification about an item in the accounts receivable column.

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### IX. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

- A. **FC Membership**: A motion was made to approve the Finance Committee's recommendation to accept Margery Entwisle as a new member of the Finance Committee [Resolution 24-13] by Dir. Gardener, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dir. Tittle, approved by vote of 5-0.
- B. **Designated/Committed Funds:** A motion was made by Dir. Nybakken to designate certain general funds as assigned fund balance for apparatus purchase and major repair [Resolution 24-11], 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dir. Gardener, approved by vote of 5-0. A motion was made by Dir. Tittle to designate certain general funds as committed fund balance for an operating reserve fund [Resolution 24-12], 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dir. Gardener, approved by vote of 5-0.
- C. **Policy Manual:** The process for updating the district Policy Manual to include references to the District Administrator was discussed.
